





SAUTEED SWISS CHARD WITH ONIONS

Ingredients: 3 lbs. fresh Swiss chard; 4 Tbsp. olive oil; 2 medium onions, halved & thinly sliced; 2 garlic cloves, finely chopped; salt & pepper

Directions: Rinse leaves thoroughly and tear or cut away thick stalks.

Chop leaves into inch-wide strips. Heat oil in a large heavy pot and cook onions and garlic with 1/2 tsp. salt & 1/4 tsp. pepper, stirring occasionally until soft. Add chard and more salt & pepper, cook covered, stirring occasionally until tender, 4 to 6 minutes. Serve immediately. Enjoy!
