



### Food of the Month: LOCUST BEAN or CAROB

Locust bean is a West African legume that grows more than 20 meters tall. Its pods dangle all over the tree's spreading crown and contain seeds and a dryish pulp that can be half sugar. The seeds are gathered by thousands of

tons and peddled by traders, often as medicinal. Chiefly, they are fermented into the famous dawadawa. This sticky, sour, cheesy solid is rich in protein, vitamins, and food energy and keeps well in tropical heat even without refrigeration. Dawadawa is popular as a seasoning but is also an important soup ingredient.

## **CAROB ALMOND FREEZER FUDGE**

Ingredients: 1/2 cup virgin coconut oil, melted; 1/4 cup natural almond butter; 1/4 cup carob powder, sifted; 1 Tbsp. unsweetened cocoa powder, sifted; 2-3 Tbsp. pure maple syrup; 1 tsp. pure vanilla extract; 1/8-1/4 tsp. fine grain sea salt; 1/2 cup crisped rice cereal (optional)

Directions: Line small 4x8 loaf pan with plastic wrap for easy removal. Mix all ingredients together in large bowl until smooth. With spatula, scoop mixture into prepared pan and smooth out. Freeze for about 20 minutes until solid. Slice into squares enjoy! Keep leftovers in freezer.
