Food of the Month: **DANDELION**

Dandelion is a weed most gardeners would like to eradicate. But it's quite multi-talented—every bit of the plant is edible! Young buds are tasty fried in butter. More than just a bright yellow garnish for soups and salads, dandelion flowers are also made into jellies, root beer, and teas. Dandelion is high in fiber; vitamins A, C, and K; and minerals iron, calcium, and potassium. It's also an antioxidant, diuretic, and fights liver disease, diabetes, and skin disease. Who knew? ☺

DANDELION JELLY

Ingredients: 3 cups packed fresh dandelion blossoms (4 oz.); 4 cups water; 4 1/2 cups sugar; 1 box powdered pectin; 2 Tbsp. bottled lemon juice; 1 drop yellow food coloring

Directions: Using thumbnail, cut and pluck yellow blossoms out of tiny green leaves. In medium saucepan, boil water. Add half the blossoms, stir, and cover. Turn off heat and steep 20 minutes. Gently strain in fine mesh strainer. Add same water back to saucepan and boil. Steep remaining blossoms 15 minutes and strain. Measure steeped liquid to 3 cups; add sugar, pectin, lemon juice, and food coloring. Bring to boil, stirring until sugar dissolves. Boil one minute then skim off foam. Pour into prepared jars and refrigerate. Enjoy!

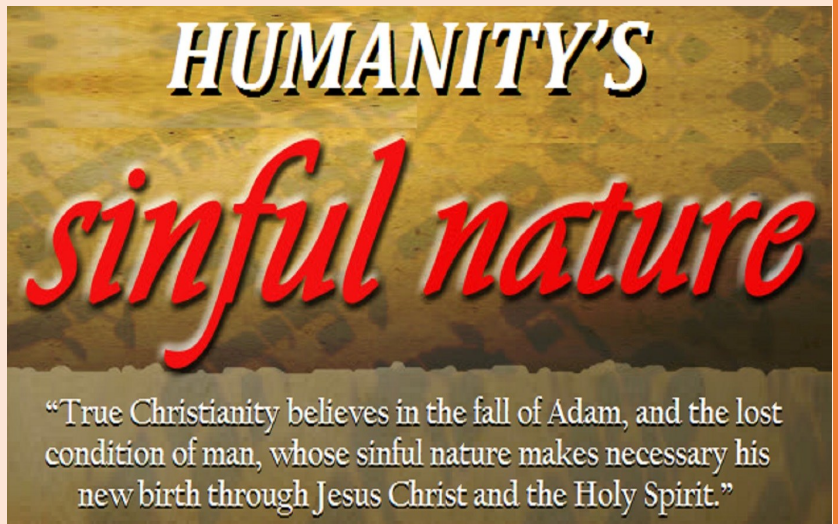
What We Believe



7. The Nature of Man

Man and woman were made in the image of God with individuality, the power and freedom to think and to do. Though created free beings, each is an indivisible unity of body, mind, and spirit, dependent upon God for life and breath and all else. When our first parents disobeyed God, they denied their dependence upon Him and fell from their high position under God. The image of God in them was marred and they became subject to death. Their descendants share this fallen nature and its consequences. They are born with weaknesses and tendencies to evil. But God in Christ reconciled the world to Himself and by His Spirit restores in penitent mortals the image of their Maker.
