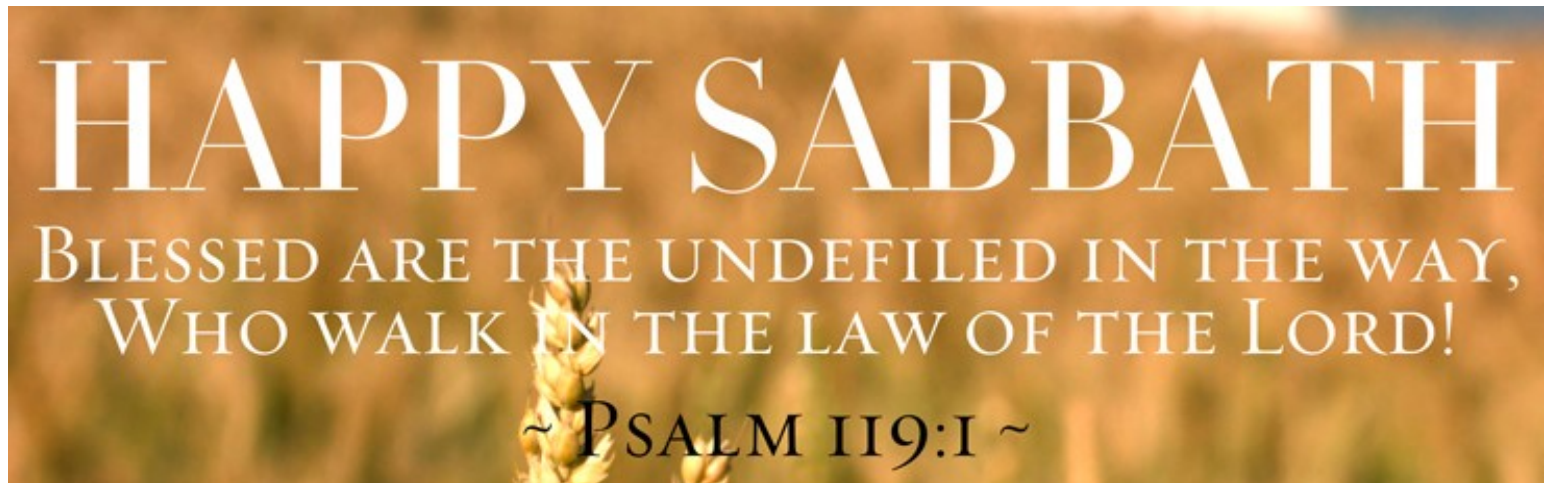

CHOPPED SOUTHWEST SALAD

Ingredients: 1 head lettuce (4-6 cups), chopped; 1 cucumber, diced; 2 tomatoes, diced; 1 bell pepper, diced; 1/2 cup corn (thawed or fresh); 1.5 cups black-eyed peas (drained & rinsed); Ranch dressing (or favorite); salt & pepper to taste; tortilla chips (optional)



Directions: Add the lettuce, cucumber, tomatoes, bell pepper, corn, and peas to a large bowl. Add the dressing and toss to coat. Add salt & pepper as needed. Top with tortilla chips to serve. Enjoy!

COCONUT-CAULIFLOWER CURRY BOWLS

Ingredients: 1 tbsp. vegetable oil; 2 medium shallots, chopped; 2 tbsp. finely chopped peeled fresh ginger; 1 tbsp. curry powder; 1 20 oz. package precut butternut squash chunks; 1 15 oz. can coconut milk, shaken; 1 15 oz. can fire-roasted diced tomatoes, drained; 4 cups cauliflower florets; 6 cups cooked rice; cilantro leaves

Directions: In 6 or 7-qt. saucepot, heat oil on medium heat. Add shallots, ginger, and curry powder; cook 5 minutes, stirring. Add squash, coconut milk, tomatoes, and 1 tsp. salt. Cover and simmer 15 minutes. Uncover, stir in cauliflower. Cook another 15 minutes until squash and cauliflower are tender, stirring occasionally. Serve over rice and garnish with cilantro.

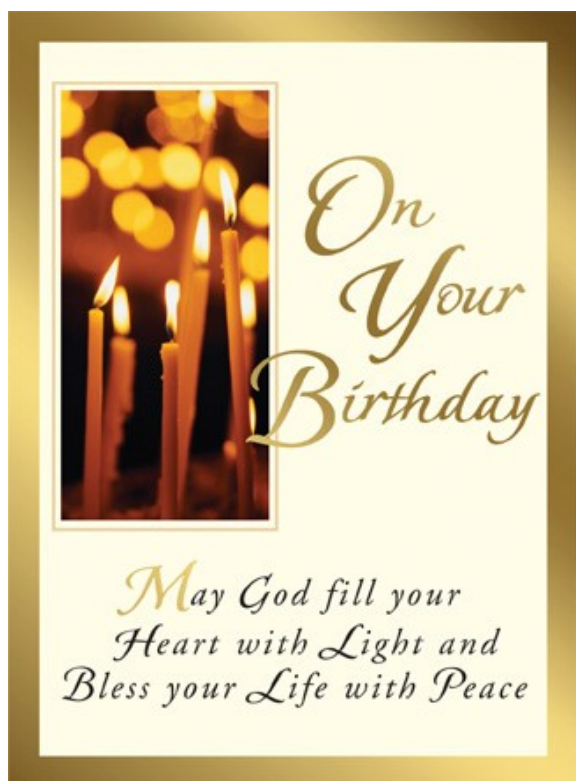
