



#### **QUICK CURRY VEGGIE BOWL**

Ingredients: 1 tbsp. vegetable oil; 3/4 cup chopped onion; 2 tbsp. curry powder, 2 tbsp. tomato paste; 2 tsp. grated fresh ginger, 1.5 tsp. minced garlic; 1/2 tsp. cinnamon; 1/2 tsp. salt; 5 cups vegetable broth; 3 red potatoes, cubed; 1 pkg. Grillers Crumbles; 2 cups frozen peas; 1 cup chopped bell pepper, 2 tbsp. coconut cream; 1/3 cup coarsely chopped cilantro; 1/2 cup dry roasted peanuts

**Directions:** In a Dutch oven heat oil over medium heat and add onion. Cook 4 minutes until onion is tender. Stir in curry powder, tomato paste, ginger, garlic, cin-



namon, and salt. Cook and stir 2 minutes until spices are fragrant. Stir in broth and potatoes and bring to a boil. Reduce heat and simmer, covered, about 15 minutes. Stir in Crumbles, peas, and bell pepper and return to boiling. Reduce heat and simmer for 2 minutes. Stir in coconut cream and heat through. Ladle into bowls and top with cilantro and peanuts. Enjoy!

# Seventh-day Adventists BELIEVE

### 12. The Church
