


- 10. Gym Night at FAA: Join us for food and games tonight as we close the Sabbath with vespers and have a friendly get together from 6:00-9:30 pm.

#### BBQ Black Beans w/Chick'n & Rice

**Ingredients:** 1/2 sweet onion, chopped; 4 pieces Gardein chick'n breast, cut into chunks; 1 tsp. ground cumin; 15-oz. can black beans, rinsed & drained; 1.5 cups barbecue sauce; oil; 3 cups cooked rice


**Directions:** In a large skillet, add a small amount of oil and saute onion,






#### 20. THE SABBATH

The beneficent Creator, after the six days of Creation, rested on the seventh day and instituted the Sabbath for all people as a memorial of Creation.
